

Power & Cable Connections



Turn the terminal over. With your fingers, remove the wiring clip from the back of the terminal (as shown).



Labeled Ports

Labeled ports on the back are defined as:
- LINE port = RJ11 (telephone) cable
- POWER port = A/C Power Adapter & Power Cord
- SERIAL port = RS232 cable
- PIN PAD port = PIN pad cable
- NET port = Ethernet cable




POWER Port


Connect Power Cord to A/C Power Adapter. Insert A/C Power Adapter into POWER port (as shown). Turn connector counter clockwise, toward back of the terminal, to lock in place. Insert other end of the Power Cord into the wall receptacle.



Insert RJ-11 cable into LINE port (as shown).



Insert Ethernet cable into NET port (as shown). Note: Bend the cable 90° at the base of the connector.



With your fingers, re-insert the wiring clip over the cables (as shown).

Receipt Paper Installation



With your fingers, open the printer cover (as shown).



Drop paper roll into paper holder (as shown). Pull paper (as shown) & close printer cover.



Pull & tear paper against the paper receipt guide. Operate terminal as normal.
